Minutes: The minutes of December 10, 2020 were unanimously approved as submitted.

Tax-deeded property sale: The Board signed a quitclaim deed transferring 0.65 acre of townowned land (Tuttle Hill Road/Map 1, Lot 57/tax-deeded in 2006) to abutters James and Candy Moore with the agreement that it be merged with their existing lot and not be retained as a separate lot. Total selling price was \$2,946.00 (\$2,500 base price and \$446.00 for deed preparation, transfer tax, and recordation). The Moores signed a voluntary property merger application which will be forwarded to Planning Board Chair Scott Sanborn for approval and recordation at the Planning Board's next schedule meeting.

Investment Policy: The Board signed the 2021 Investment Policy as required by State statute.

Intent to Cut: The Board approved an Intent to Cut for the Gunn property/New Colony Road/Map 3, Lot 47. Logger is Walter Buckwold.
