<i>Grant:</i> Trish Weekes submitted documentation for the Board and the town clerk to sign in regards to a Moose Plate grant which will go toward the Town House roof restoration. Tamara motioned that the Town of Orange accept the Moose Plate grant in the amount of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) and that Trish Weekes, town treasurer and member of the Town House Restoration Committee, accepts the grant monies for the Town of Orange. Betsy seconded. Motion passed unanimously in favor. The documents were signed and notarized.
<i>Highway:</i> Skip said he spoke with Road Agent Scott Sanborn regarding additional gravel for the upper section of Peaslee Road. Skip stated that Scott said he would like to wait until spring. Tamara will request a road updated and work timetable from Scott.
<i>Burnt Hill Beavers</i> : Aaron said that Scott Borthwick (Estate Wildlife Services) reports that the beavers creating the flooded culvert on Burnt Hill have been eradicated. Aaron said the water is flowing adequately though the culvert. Aaron said the lower dam should be broken up to allow for the original water flow.
<i>UVLSRPC:</i> Betsy posed the question to Planning Board Chair Scott Sanborn about the value of retaining a membership with the Upper Valley lake Sunapee Regional Planning Commission. She said that Scott feels the organization is beneficial to the town, including when preparing the town's Master Plan, which is done every ten years.
