BUILDING PERMITS & DRIVEWAY PERMITS

A permit issued by the Board of Selectmen shall be required before beginning operations of placement of foundations, alterations, removal, demolition, or placement on a lot of a building or structure, including manufactured housing. A permit issued by the New Hampshire State Highway Department shall be required before beginning any excavation or construction of a driveway or private road to be built off of a state highway. A permit issued by the Town of Orange Road Agent shall be required before beginning any excavation or construction of a driveway or private road to be built off of a town road. The applicant shall properly install all culverts required by the Town or State to the specifications set forth in the permit. (Section VI, Town of Orange Building Ordinance)
