Old Business;

- We have again retained Aaron Poland to mow the town house and cemeteries.
- There is a date set for the burial of Elizabeth Mills on Sat. May 27, at 11 am at the Church Cem.
- Donna has volunteered to distribute Jugs of water in the cemeteries for cleaning monuments as volunteers time allows. They will need soft brushes. They can work on their own time at this.
- Gulley, Donna and Anita will clear remaining brush and old wood at the Town Common before Memorial day.
